

RE/YM Volunteer Job Descriptions



ALL ADULTS working with children & youth in the Madison diocese are required to have a standard diocesan background check and attend an adult awareness session called **Virtus: Protecting God's Children**.

This session is about a two hour time commitment, and is held throughout the year all around the diocese.

Early Childhood or Grades 1-5 Catechist/Teacher

As effective models of the Catholic faith, catechists help stimulate a child's faith development. A structured curriculum, lesson plans and all teaching materials are provided to help the catechist prepare classroom activities for a class of 8-12 children. Each catechist is assigned an assistant or co teacher. Catechists should have an ability to communicate and manage a group of students. Catechist training & formation sessions held throughout the year help you develop teaching strategies.

Catechist Assistant or Co Teacher

Assistants work closely with the lead catechist in whatever capacity the two agree upon. Assistants are often the "extra set of hands" so very much needed when working with small children. While the assistant does not have the primary responsibility for planning the classroom activities, he or she **may** occasionally be asked to do so in the absence of the catechist.

Substitute Catechist

Occasionally, Catechists have personal commitments or illnesses that prevent them from teaching as scheduled. Working with a lesson plan provided the Substitute handles the scheduled class using the Lesson Plan materials and information provided by the Religious Education office.

Office Volunteer

During class hours the Office Volunteer will assist with attendance and in preparing class sets of craft materials, material for upcoming special events, and perform other office duties as needed.

Hall Monitor

During class hours the Hall Monitor will ensure that no one is in the hall that does not belong there and also

ensures that children who need to use the lavatory or get a drink of water return to the classroom in a timely manner. They may be asked to walk a sick child to the office or handle other issues that may arise.

Childcare Volunteer

During class hours the Childcare Volunteer will care for catechists' preschoolers in the pre school classroom while catechists are teaching. Toys & equipment are provided. Adults/Teens are only responsible for a small number of preschoolers.

Middle School & High School Small Group Leaders

work in pairs with a co-leader to facilitate small group activities & discussion. Detailed session plans are provided. Regular training for small group leaders helps you develop your personal faith as well as giving you practical how-to's, techniques and strategies for your small group. Small groups are 8-12 youth. The challenge is to model & share from your own active faith life and encourage trust, openness and community building within your small group in fun and creative ways. Each week offers opportunities for social, input, discussion and prayer. Other opportunities for community service are also encouraged and offered throughout the year.

Video/Photo Person

A person willing to come in to various youth sessions or social events and take photos of kids in activities or just hangin' out, hamming it up for the camera. We need to continually update records of activities for parish bulletins, directories, newsletters, marketing and more.

HS Computer/Audio/Visual Tech Person

Someone well versed in computers who can help put together and present various presentations, slide show, power point, including video clips, music, graphics, etc. There's no limits to the creative possibilities!

Community Service Project Coordinator

This person would help find, set-up & publicize community service projects and social justice outreach activities geared especially towards middle and high school teens, but also open to all parishioners. You could work in conjunction with area high schools, & service organizations.

Concession Manager &/or Fundraising Coordinator

You would be trained & guided from what has been done before. This person helps organize, recruit & directs volunteers to help with various fundraising activities. This can be done a number of people or a team or in pairs.
