### Helping Them Remember....

\*Pick up two leaves off the ground; discuss how they are alike and different. Point out to your child that God created people and each one of us is very different and special, yet very much a like. Remind your child to Thank God for creating us and making us members of his family.

When you tuck your child in each night ask your child to name some of the things he/she saw today that we should be thankful for.

### The Difference Faith Makes...

Young children base their understanding of the world on the 5 senses. **Smell:** the sweet smell of our child after a bath, popcorn, rain, flowers
